IS NATIONWIDE GUIDANCE ABOUT SOCIAL DISTANCING PABOUT TO CHANGE?

Today, in a presentation to the International Association of Public Transport (UITP) TfL Director of Public Transport Service Planning, Geoff Hobbs stated that with full social distancing measures of 2 metres, LUL would only be able to run at 13% of normal capacity. He hinted strongly that a reduction would ease the problem. Chief Operating Officer of MTA New York, Mario Peloquin also made similar comments. With both New York and London hinting that a reduction in distance is required, we believe P.H.E is likely to change its guidance. We will be monitoring this closely.
