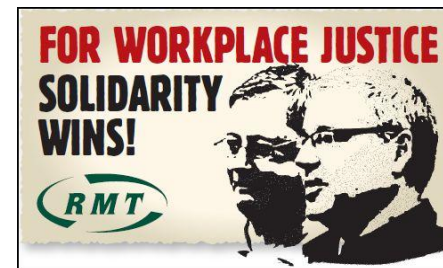

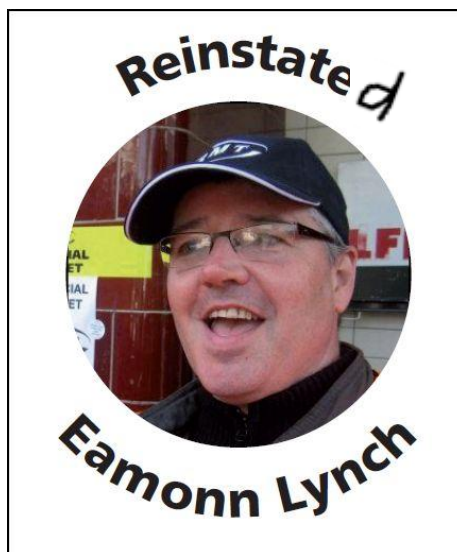

This week in 2010 saw the 2nd strike action to prevent the unlawful victimisation of our workmate.

The Bakerloo Line's General Manager- Mr Lance Ramsey informed passengers: "A proposed strike by drivers belonging to the RMT Union may affect Bakerloo line services on Saturday. Trains will continue to run on the line but your journey may take longer".- *How wrong was he!*

Thousands of passengers who had made plans on the basis of this promise were let down as Bakerloo drivers shutdown the line.



This was a clear message to management that we are prepared to stand together to stop managers picking off our drivers at will.

For the first time ever the bakerloo line was shut down on a line issue.

In the run up to the strike the mood of solidarity was infectious and drivers took courage and strength in their resolve to take action to defend their colleague.
