

INDUSTRIAL ACTION: ADVICE TO STATION STAFF



From Friday 27th September 2019, staff on District East are taking part in industrial action short of strike, in response to a surge in violence at work, and against lone-working.

From Friday 27th September 2019, members are instructed:

- If you are lone-working, stay within your place of safety. You do not have to work from the gateline.
- If you are lone-working and asked to assist with an incident, request a second member of LU staff. If that request is not met, explain you are taking part in industrial action and will not attend alone.
- If you are lone-working and need to assist with detrainment, request a second member of LU staff to assist. If that request is not met, explain you are taking part in industrial action and will not detrain alone.

If you suspect any criminal activity, request assistance from the police and do not put yourself in an unsafe situation.

This is a lawful and legitimate industrial action. If anyone tries to bully you into breaking the action, or if you need any further advice, contact the local reps or the Branch Chair or Secretary
